Reason for Visit/History: Not eating much, back legs stopped working last month on October 11th, By the 19th, front legs started having problems as well. Has been to multiple vets multiple times and cannot figure out a diagnosis. Rads and BW performed, antibiotic and pain med treatment done. Also given omnivore care which he ate ok. Took a turn for the worse about 4 days ago and arms and legs got much worse and mobility much worse.

Also has 40 gallon tank with 150 watt basking (90-115 basking temp) with UVB that he is sometimes in. Metal screen. 30 gallon tank to sleep in- 60watt night bulb. 70-85 at night. Sleeps on towels.
